

Opening and Saving a Spreadsheet

When you open a spreadsheet from a BLOOMBERG ANYWHERE® window, Microsoft® Excel launches through the Bloomberg Anywhere application in a new window. In that window, the add-in tools and API formulas function normally.

To utilize the Bloomberg Excel Add-In in the Bloomberg Anywhere environment, launch the Bloomberg Anywhere version of Excel. You can launch the Bloomberg Anywhere version of Excel in several ways, including:


- Open a spreadsheet from a function, such as the *Personal File Manager (FILE)* or *Excel Template Library (XLTP)* function.

- Open a spreadsheet from a message attachment in the *Message (MSG)* function.

For more information on MSG, see MSG <Help>.
